### ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS

- I. Any LSU J.D. student in good standing who has completed at least one full semester of full-time study with a grade point average of 2.6 or higher is eligible to participate in the program.
- II. In order to earn the Graduate Certificate, a student must complete at least 18 credit hours within the Certificate Curriculum, including both mandatory and elective courses, and satisfy all service requirements and applied learning experiences related to the program.
- III. A student must earn a grade of 2.4 or above in each course used to satisfy the certificate curriculum and a 3.2 or above grade point average in all coursework satisfying the Certificate Curriculum.
- IV. A student's overall grade point average in Law Center coursework must be at least 3.0.
