### Faculty and Staff Highlights

Professor Christine Corcos presented a paper, *Ethicity, Gender, and Diversity: Law and Justice on Some U.S. Television Shows*, at an Author Meets Reader Session during the Annual Meeting of the Law and Society Association, June 7-10, Toronto, Ontario.

Professor Bill Corbett was elected as a 2018 Fellow of the College of Labor and Employment Lawyers.

Professor Baier was interviewed by local NBC television news regarding *Trump v. Hawaii*. He explained the split decision. When asked by the reporter, he voted with Chief Justice Roberts and the Court majority. Professor Baier also discussed *Trump v.
