Subject: Remote Classes Still On! (Campus Still Closed)

Dear Students:

As predicted, LSU's physical campus is closed tomorrow, which includes our building. But just as Associate Dean Carroll indicated in her message earlier today (below), while we follow LSU for campus closure, we are now able to continue our classes online/remotely, at least in advance of a storm or during other times when there has been no power outage. This will be the case tomorrow.

As a result, despite the situation for the undergraduate classes (which are on a different calendar, as you know), **Law Center classes will continue on a remote/online basis on Monday in all cases where it is possible. This will include all of the classes that are already remote/online/distance AND most of the "in person" classes as well.** Most "in person" courses are all already set up for remote delivery; the only remaining question is equipment and network availability off campus. Students must check Moodle and check their email for specific information from their professors with respect to Monday in-person classes.

STAY SAFE, everyone! And that means #MaskUpLSU, be ready for the storm(s), and keep your physical distance—now is still not the time for a non-socially distanced hurricane party (really).

We will be back in touch tomorrow late afternoon with more information.

Dear Students -

In true 2020 fashion, as you know, we are all anxiously watching the development of two storms in the Gulf of Mexico which may affect our operations this week. The Law Center follows all main campus decisions on closure. As a result, you should monitor LSU.edu for up to the minute updates regarding the status of in-person classes.

We will, however, hold all online classes this week as scheduled so long as conditions in the Baton Rouge area permit. If in-person classes must be canceled because of campus closure, those will move online if possible. Each professor will be contacting you through Moodle if campus closes with an update on that particular course.

In the meantime, you should plan to have all materials with you that you may need for classes through the middle of the week. If you have course materials at the Law Center in a locker, the Law Center building is open from 10 AM to 6 PM

today. I suggest you retrieve those items today so that you will be prepared for remote learning if it is necessary.
