Following on LSU's earlier announcement, the Law Center will be closed and no classes will be held tomorrow, Thursday, August 27, because of Hurricane Laura.

While our immediate area is not expected to take a direct hit from this hurricane, we do remain on the east side of the storm where bands of thunderstorms and high winds and possible tornadoes will remain a strong risk. We are already experiencing some strong storms in Baton Rouge. Any movement east in the trajectory of the hurricane between now and landfall will substantially increase the risk. These risks and conditions are simply not conducive for hosting virtual classes that require resources that may be unavailable to any number of faculty and students throughout the day tomorrow.

I will send more information by email about the status of campus and classes for Friday when I learn more from the University tomorrow and after we see what has happened with the storm's passage through the area.
