Professor Levasseur's "Treatise" on "Louisiana Law of Obligations in General" has been published and is now available. Justice John Weimer wrote the Preface. At this time, the Treatise is listed by Carolina Academic Press, the publisher. He has also published, with some help from Trahan and Gruning, "The Legal System of Iran", in the series "Foreign Legal Systems" published by Carolina Academic Press.
