### Faculty Highlights

Prof. Bill Corbett accepted an offer of publication from the Oklahoma Law Review for his article *Intolerable Asymmetry and Uncertainty: Congress Should Right the Wrongs of the Civil Rights Act of 1991*.

Professor Keith Hall is one of the editors (and a chapter author) of the book “The Regulation of Decommissioning, Abandonment and Reuse Initiatives in the Oil and Gas Industry,” which was recently published by Wolters Kluwer.

Professor Richards’ article, *A Historical Review of the State Police Powers and Their Relevance to the COVID-19 Pandemic of 2020*, will be published by the Journal of National Security Law, a peer-reviewed journal published by Georgetown Law Center. The article will also be reprinted in: *COVID-19: The Legal Challenges* (Stephen Dycus & Eugene R. Fidell eds., Carolina Acad. Press, 2021).

The Louisiana Law Review has agreed to publish Professor Smith’s article *Sexual Misconduct by Louisiana Lawyers*.

On October 16th, Prof. Ryan will participate in a virtual conference hosted by the Harvard Law School Human Rights Program in which she will be presenting on indirect discrimination cases before the European Court of Human Rights.

Prof. Olivier Moréteau presented on “The Role of Civil Codes in France and Louisiana,” American Association of Law Librarians, Foreign, Comparative, and International Law Section, Civil Law and Legal Systems Webinar, July 21, 2020. He authored a foreword to Ibrahim Abdouraoufi, *L’OHADA ET LA COMMON LAW* (L’Harmattan, Études africaines, 2020). *COMPARATIVE LEGAL HISTORY* (O. Moréteau, A. Masferrer, K. Modéer eds., Edward Elgar, Research Handbooks in Comparative Law Series, 2019) is now available in paperback edition.
