### Faculty Highlights

Professor Keith Hall was interviewed regarding natural gas issues on the “This Climate Podcast” at Indiana University on January 14, 2021. Later that day, he was interviewed by Court TV regarding the BP P.L.C. v. Baltimore case that is being argued before the United States Supreme Court. In addition, he spoke on the subject “Communication with Opposing Counsel and Landowners” at the “Annual Mid-Winter Education Webinar” of the San Antonio Association of Professional Landmen on January 21, 2021.

He taught his annual Comparative Tort Law class at the Jean Moulin University, Lyon, in December 2020, on Zoom, and is presently teaching a short U.S. Contract Law class, also on Zoom, at the University of Nantes.

### CCLS and International Programs

Seven foreign students (six LL.M. Candidates and one Exchange Student) from Chile, France, and Honduras started at LSU Law this January, after a three-day orientation.

Two distinguished visitors from Argentina visited LSU Law in January: Professor Santiago Legarre (Catholic University Buenos Aires) presented at the Eric Voegelin Institute and met with international students. Professor Alfonso Santiago, one of the founders of Austral University

(Buenos Aires) also visited, at a time when the bilateral agreement Austral-LSU Law is up for renewal.
